Bidding

Your bid (oral, written, or digital) constitutes a contract to buy. Please give careful thought to your bidding.

Payment

- Payment by the successful Live Auction bidder must be made at the time of sale to the Auction Staff.
- Accepted forms of payment include: Cash, Check, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, and Discover.
- If the winning bidder leaves before completing Auction checkout, the sale will be cancelled. The American Heart Association cannot arrange payment or item pickup after the event closes.

Everything is "As-Is"

All packages are offered by the American Heart Association AS IS and without recourse to the Association for any defect, injury, damage, or other issue that may arise or become apparent with respect to a particular package.

The American Heart Association disclaims all warranties with respect to each prize, including but not limited to any warranty for a particular purpose.

Package winners and guests are responsible for:
