Did you know that cardiovascular diseases and stroke claim the lives of more Americans than the next seven leading causes of death combined? The Sweethearts Program is designed to educate and empower high school sophomore girls while engaging them in the American Heart Association's Mission: *Building healthier lives, free of cardiovascular disease and stroke*. Sweethearts participate in educational programs and activities over the course of the school year while becoming heart advocates. Participants also develop team building concepts, earn volunteer hours, and gain valuable leadership skills.

Sweetheart activities begin in August and culminate in May of 2019 at the Northwest Arkansas Heart Ball, where the Sweethearts are highlighted as valuable volunteers and young women of strength and character. The experience and knowledge received through the Sweethearts Program have an immediate and positive impact on the participants and our community!

Sweetheart Program Description & Mission

The American Heart Association Sweethearts are high school sophomores who (from August through May) actively participate in a program designed to teach them about heart healthy lifestyles and about the prevention of heart disease through education and volunteerism. Through this program, these young ladies learn that heart disease is the number one killer of Americans. During their tenure as Sweethearts, they learn the mission of the American Heart Association and how to implement those goals on a daily basis.

The mission of the Sweethearts Program is to empower a new generation with lifesaving knowledge while developing a genuine commitment to life-long heart health, community service and leadership. Sweethearts accrue volunteer hours, learn valuable leadership skills and the concepts of team building as well as fundraising to support important research for heart disease and stroke. They are trained in Hands Only CPR and learn other heart health related information. After <u>successfully completing</u> the program, the Sweethearts are presented at the Heart Ball to highlight their achievements throughout the year.

Sweetheart Financial Commitment:

The program fee is **\$2,000.** This must be paid in full by **April 10th, 2019**. You can pay it in monthly or quarterly installments, or all at once. Payments can be made as soon as you sign up, and we can set up the payment options that work best for your family.

*A \$250 deposit is due by June 1, 2018.

We also set a **fundraising goal** for each Sweetheart of **\$1,000**. This is not mandatory, and if your daughter does not raise the full \$1,000, you are not responsible for paying the difference. We help the girls reach their goal through letter writing campaigns, telethons, give-back nights, and other fundraisers throughout the year.

<u>Sweetheart Activities + Community Service Hours</u>

Sweetheart activities begin August 2018-May 2019. We ask that the Sweethearts attend as many "Core" activities as possible, but also understand that school and family conflicts will arise. We ask the girls to complete **25** community service hours. They earn these hours by attending core Sweetheart events, volunteer opportunities given on their program calendar, additional volunteer opportunities that will be shared as they arise, and even social media postings! The American Heart Association will provide an opportunity to earn 40+ hours through various events and programs listed on their calendar.

• The Sweetheart that completes the most hours will be presented an award at Heart Ball.

Sweetheart Fundraising

Sweethearts are given a goal to raise \$1,000 for the American Heart Association outside of the program fees. A fundraising kick-off will be held in the fall that combines a telethon party and a letter writing campaign. Sweethearts will also be supplied with an online fundraising page in August and additional tools to help reach their goal.

The deadline to reach the fundraising goal is **April 20**th, **2019**.

• The Sweetheart with the most successful fundraising campaign will be presented an award at Heart Ball.

Northwest Arkansas Heart Ball

The Northwest Arkansas Heart Ball is the premier social event consisting of dinner, dancing, entertainment and an auction. The event attracts the area's leading corporate executives and community leaders. This event will be for all Sweethearts who have successfully completed the program.

Each Sweetheart member receives **three** seats to the Heart Ball for herself and two parents/guardians. These three tickets are included in the program cost. Sweethearts can purchase a maximum of six *additional* seats to attend the Heart Ball at a discounted rate. All purchased tickets must be paid for when the order is placed with the American Heart Association.



Heart Ball Gown Requirements

The Heart Ball is considered a black-tie social event, and Sweethearts must adhere to the guidelines listed below.

- ✓ Color of your choice; floor length only; no high slits; no full beading; no backless; no spandex; no gloves; no low necklines
- ✓ Gowns need to be purchased and altered by March 1, 2019 so they can wear them for the Citiscapes photo shoot.

Sweetheart Photographs

A CitiScapes photographer will take individual and group photographs of the Sweethearts in their Heart Ball gowns in March 2019. Individual portraits will be used for the Heart Ball Program. Group photographs will be used in an article featured in the May 2019 issue of CitiScapes Metro Monthly Magazine.

*ALL Sweethearts are required to attend the photo shoot. Make-up sessions will only be scheduled for Sweethearts who are out of state for school or team reasons.

Parent or Guardian Volunteers

We would be delighted to get interested parents or guardians more involved. There will be volunteer opportunities available throughout the year at many activities and AHA events. Please let us know if you are interested in becoming more involved.

Sweetheart Attire

Sweethearts should dress appropriately for all activities. Bare stomachs should not be visible during any Sweetheart event. Shorts and skirts should be of a respectable and reasonable length. Casual attire (sweetheart shirts + jeans) will be appropriate for the majority of their activities.

Social Media

As a Sweetheart, the young women will be representing not only themselves, but the American Heart Association as well. There will be an expectation of class and leadership to be shown not only during AHA events, but all the time, including posts on social media. Social media accounts will be monitored, and if a post does not display the values and character expected of a Sweetheart, parents and Sweethearts will be contacted.
